- Gain general agronomy skills, such as scouting and identification of weeds and insects.
- Assist with Field Insight plots, including emergence, stand counts, photography, and drone imagery.
- Assist with field signs for plots and customer fields.
- Help set up and attend field day tours and other events as needed.
- Assist agronomists with various soil and tissue sampling.
- Other duties as assigned.
